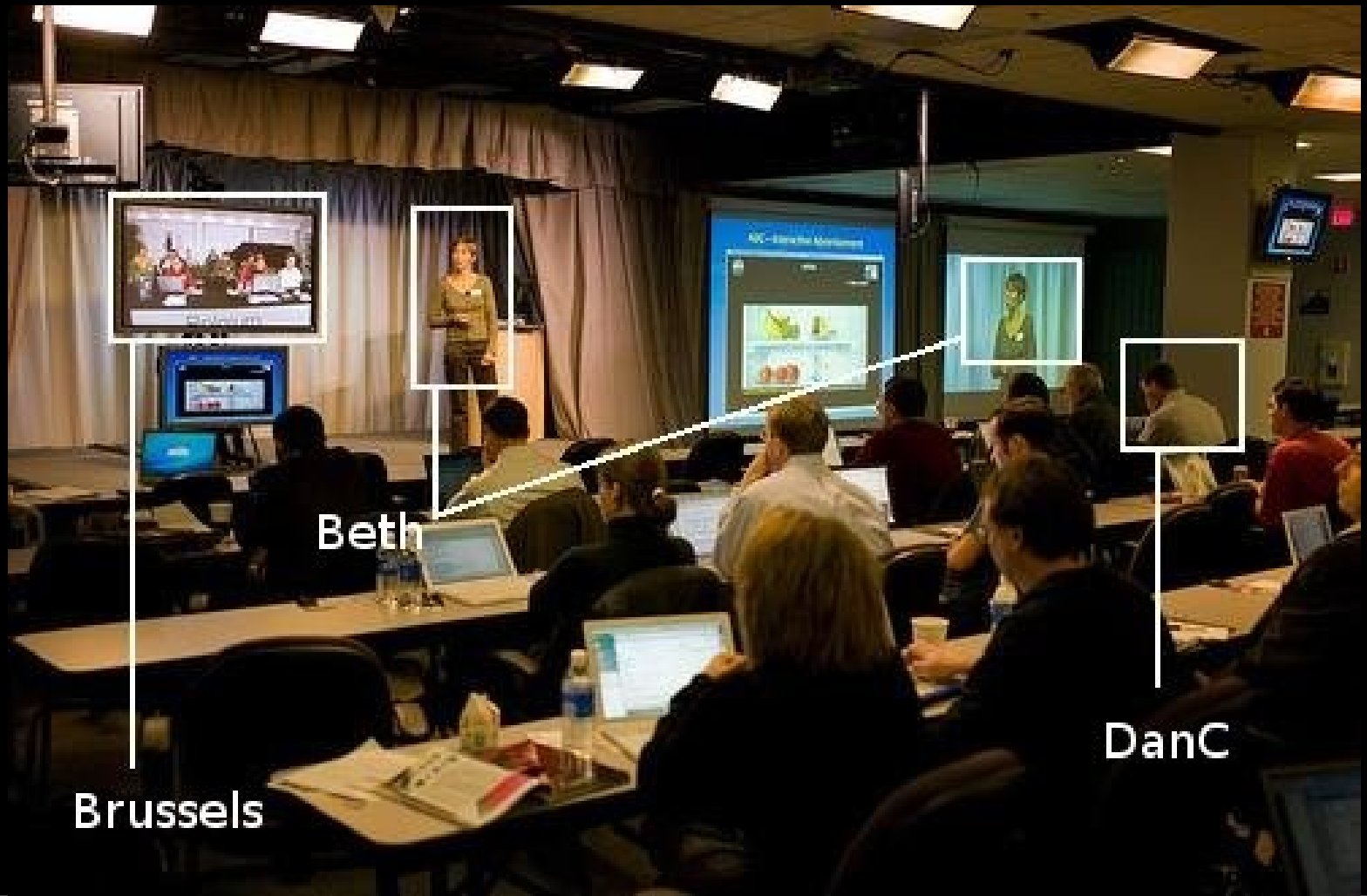

September 17, 2007

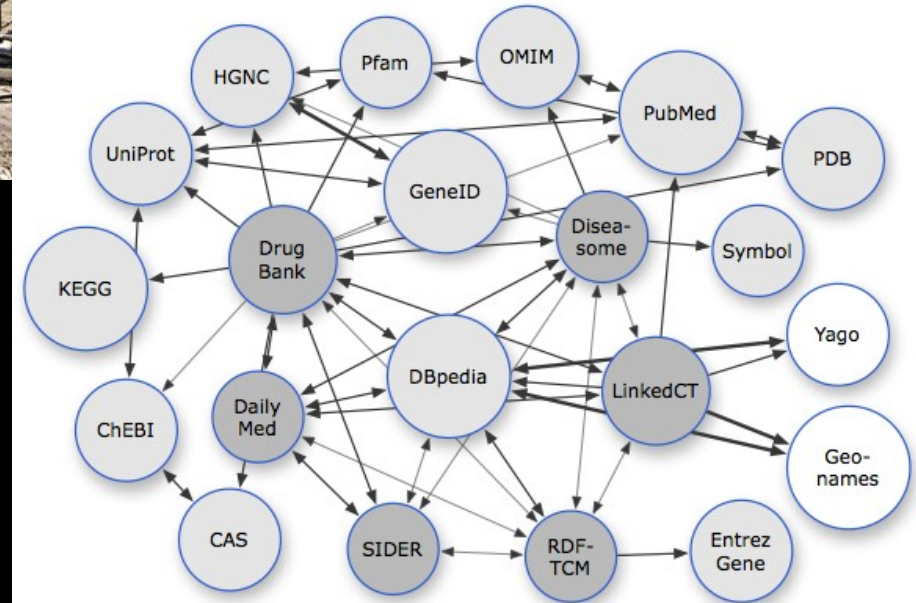


Web of Linked Open Data
